



Your Safety Is Important to Us: What You Can Expect Before and During Your Stay

We are working with **CDC and national hospitality industry recommendations** to ensure your safety.

Please note, bookings are at your own risk due to the COVID Pandemic. Additionally, we reserve the right to take your temperature upon arrival and cancel any stay based on local, state and Federal guidance, including an elevated temperature or displaying of COVID-related symptoms.



Our **housekeeping staff cleans and disinfects** our guest rooms and public spaces, including sanitizing all hard touch points in every room prior to check in.

All guests will be required to wear masks while they're in the lobby and corridors.

Hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout the building and we'll encourage **social distancing** between guests.

Our **spa services are open**, but our game room and Underground are **closed**.

When possible, we will **be leaving rooms vacant for at least 24 hours** prior to your arrival. We will **not have housekeeping service** during your stay.

Upon arrival to work, all **staff will have their temperatures checked**. Any staff with a higher than normal temp, has been coughing or doesn't feel well will be sent home.

All **staff will be required to wear face masks** and will be required to **wash hands** or use sanitizer at least hourly.



Currently, the Broadway Grille is open daily for breakfast and Thursday-Monday for lunch and dinner. Indoor and outdoor seating on our balconies is available.

Takeout food and drinks are available, too, and guests are welcome to bring food back to their rooms or take it outside to the park or trail. **Craft beer** will be available to-go as pints, growlers or 6-packs and we'll offer **cocktails** to go.
